

Monthly Police Report

April 2019

Auto Accidents:

04/07-A two vehicle collision occurred at the intersection of Stoner Avenue and West Drive. No injuries and no tow.

Aided Cases:

04/20-A visitor of a Nassau Drive resident was removed to North Shore Hospital after suffering symptoms of possible intoxication

04/20-A resident of Greenacre Court was evaluated for symptoms of pain and sickness at the home by emergency medical staff. Aided refused any further medical attention or transport to hospital.

Ambulance Calls:

The Vigilant Fire Company Ambulance responded to all of the above aided cases.

Alarms:

Fires:

Larcenies:

Miscellaneous:

-Police were called to investigate a suspicious motor vehicle with occupant on Sutton Court. Police observed the vehicle in question and spoke with occupant. Occupant was a process server with proper ID.

-A tow company was assisted with traffic control in vicinity of 75 Arleigh Road while removing a disabled vehicle.

-A call for medic alert was given at an address on Arleigh Road. Police and ambulance responded and were unable to gain access. Fire company took door to gain access. Home was unoccupied and address given was incorrect. Door secured by PD and homeowner notified.

-Temporary No Parking signs were deployed throughout the village in order to alleviate possible traffic /parking conditions.
