

Minutes of the Board of Trustees Meeting
Village of Kensington, 2 Nassau Drive, Great Neck, NY
March 15, 2023

The Board meeting was brought to order by Mayor Lopatkin at 7:30pm.

Mayor Lopatkin made a motion to approve the February board minutes, all in favor.

Commanding Officer Lt. Giraulo updated the Village on the current standing of the Village and future projects.

Lt Giraulo states there was a slight uptick in grand larcenies of automobiles and the village had its first burglary in ten years.

Auto accidents were down this past year in part to their increased enforcement.

The Village of Kensington continues to rate as one of the safest villages to live in.

The police dept is exploring new technologies that will assist the police in the day-to-day deterrents of crime.

The Village obtained a DASNY grant to purchase an electric police vehicle.

Lt Giraulo noted his appreciation for the residents; Cooperation between the police and the residents including their input and increased awareness of suspicious activity provides for a safer village.

The Mayor and the Board of Trustees recognized years of services and presented a gift to both Lt Giraulo for 25 years of service and Trustee Hendler for 22 years of service.

A pebble finish for the kiddie pool was selected and will be ordered for the upcoming refurbishment of the village kiddie pool.

Mayor Lopatkin discussed the destination Great Neck street banners that will be placed throughout Middle Neck Rd. The mayor and the board discussed the cost and agreed to take part in this wonderful opportunity to unify the peninsula.

At next month's board meeting on April 19th, the board will have a discussion regarding the village pool and the upcoming season.

On a motion of Mayor Lopatkin, seconded by Trustee Bornstein accept the Police and Treasurers reports.
