

Minutes of the Board of Trustees Meeting
Village of Kensington, 2 Nassau Drive, Great Neck, NY
July 17, 2024
8:00pm – Village Hall

The Board meeting was brought to order by Deputy Mayor Greener at 8:00pm.

Deputy Mayor Greener made a motion to approve the June board minutes, all in favor.

Deputy Mayor Greener explained that there would be a photo op at the Village Hall with Bruce Blakeman and Mazi Pilip regarding the grant that our Village is receiving for speed signage throughout the village. We are waiting on certification from Nassau County so that we may order the speed signs.

Deputy Mayor Greener stated that last month the board spoke about the village acquiring a policy to increase our excess liability. The board decided not to raise the limit; the consensus is that the mayor and the board feel it is not necessary at this time.

There will be a Vigilant zoom meeting on July 24th regarding the contracts between Vigilant and the surrounding villages. They will go over comments made by the villages (including ours) regarding the new contract. Deputy Mayor Greener will attend this meeting and bring the information back at the next board meeting.

The village board does not meet in August, the next board meeting will be September 11th at 8pm.

A resident that attended the meeting this evening, asked us to look into a stop sign near her home that has an overgrowth of greenery obstructing the sign. Our DPW Supervisor will be informed.
